After a short break, the Base CDR introduced our guest speaker:

RM1 (SS) Gary Wallick, USN (Vet.)

Gary Wallick served onboard USS Bergall (SSN 667) from December 1986 to April 1991, separating from active duty as RM1(SS). He served 20 months at Mare Island during completion of a refueling overhaul, then 2 Northern Runs, an ICEX, and UNITAS South American cruise as deployed staff. He has been an active member of the USS Bergall (SS 320/SSN 667) Association for 12 years.

Gary served on the USS Colorado (SSN 788) Commissioning Committee with Captain John Mackin as his mentor, and on the USS Delaware (SSN 791) Commissioning Committee. He is the Founder and Immediate Past President of the Delaware Submarine Association, and a Trustee of USSVI Mid Atlantic Base in Dover, Delaware.

Gary spoke to us about "Submarine Clubs" which act in direct support of active-duty submarines and their crews. He was asked to speak to us by both Chuck Martin and Tim Oliver.

Tim Oliver has created a "Submarine Club Guide." This is a handbook to stand up and operate such a submarine club. Since the start in May of 2016, Gary has accomplished much as the formal liaison between the USS Delaware (SSN791) and the civilian community, as well as Delaware state and local associations and businesses. The club supports the USS Delaware whenever she returns to port and creates fun outings for the crew (morale boosters). One such outing was a field trip to a foster home for 40 children in Delaware – from the submarine's homeport of Norfolk, VA. Anyone interested in starting a submarine club should contact Tim Oliver

The submarine club raises funds from local businesses and citizens. They have created a new ship's bell for USS Delaware (SSN 791). The new bell sits across the street from the old bell from the Battleship USS Delaware (BB 28)
